One way to collaborate is to share program practices that are proven to work. Sharing has the potential to quickly increase performance. As a result, we encourage programs to share promising practices or proven techniques with the afterschool community.

Publication Payment

Amount - \$250

All Promising Practices are eligible for a \$250 payment upon publication online at www.springfieldafterschool.org. Please complete a Promising Practice Application. Checks will be made payable to the submitting agency or organization. No payments will be issued to individuals. Any supporting documents submitted such as forms and charts must also be suitable for publication and will not be returned. Promising Practices may also be included in semi-annual progress reports to OJJDP.

It is imperative that the afterschool program information posted on the online database remain current. Please review your organization's information within 30 days of submitting a Promising Practice so that your payment is not delayed.

Presentation Payment

Amount - \$250

Once your Promising Practice is published, your organization is eligible for an additional payment of \$250 if you are selected to teach others how to replicate your practice at a Power & Promise of Afterschool Conference or Summer Institute. Once selected, a Training Plan Application that includes learning outcomes, timeline, and hands on activities must be submitted for review at least one week prior to the scheduled training session(s). Our goal is for each participant to leave the training with the tools and information necessary for implementing the practice in their own organization. Training Plans will not be returned, may be published in an online training library and may also be included in semi-annual progress reports to OJJDP. Checks will be made payable to the submitting agency or organization. No payments will be issued to individuals.
